Optional TALENT Competition **Information – Rules – Regulations**

👑 Talent Competition will be held Thursday, June 1, at 6:30, p.m.

👑 Competition Divisions

Junior Petite Talent – 5 to 7 years

Must be at least five (5) years of age and no older than seven (7) years of age on June 1, 2017 to compete in the Junior Petite division.

Senior Petite Talent – 8 to 10 years

Must be at least eight (8) years of age and no older than ten (10) years of age on June 1, 2017 to compete in the Junior Petite division.

Teen Talent – 11 to 19 years

Open to ALL Contestants



👑 What are the Judges looking for? Presentation, performance, self-assurance, execution and entertainment value.

👑 Talent judging will be done by a separate panel of qualified judges that are independent of and in no way connected to the areas of pageant competition.

👑 Talent results will have no bearing on the selection of queens and the outcome of the Teen Princess Louisiana Pageant.



👑 Contestant may enter up to 2 (two) entries. The LOWEST of the 2 (two) scores will be thrown out and only the HIGHEST score will be used to determine final placement for awards.

👑 Talent time limit: 2 (two) minutes OR less.

👑 Pageant furnishes: Piano, CD player, microphone(s), sound operator & stage hand.

👑 You provide your own music; 2 (two) Talent CD's per entry. Talent music must be the ONLY track on your Talent CD and must have a definite end! Each CD & case/cover must be labeled with Contestant Name & Competition Division and are due at Pageant Check-in/Registration.

👑 Only functional props will be allowed and must be easily moved on & off stage.

👑 Talent attire/costume is to be of your choosing, in good taste, modest & age appropriate for the type of talent.

👑 Talent presentation may not include any object or substance that is deemed dangerous by the pageant including fire, knives, etc.

👑 Each contestant will be allowed one, but no more than two performances of their talent(s) during talent rehearsal the day of Competition. This time is also used for production staff to set sound levels and lighting.

(If there is a fade, it must be recorded & completed within the time limit); **e.** Music NOT ending by the 2 minute mark could constitute disqualification.
